- WHAT IS THE LEE FOUNDATION?

 1. Issues reports by members and contributors on nutrition and the allied sciences.

 2. Carries on research for methods of retaining vital food factors in commercial foodstuffs. The Foundation also licenses processes for separating and concentrating these factors from foodstuffs to food and pharmaceutical manufacturers although it believes this to be but a temporary solution to the problem. This makes the Foundation a self-supporting but non-profit institution.
